

Create Gold Jewelry



Many pieces of jewelry are included in the exhibition *Afghanistan: Hidden Treasures from the National Museum, Kabul*. Archaeologists found beautiful, elaborate items during their research and have uncovered meaningful ways in which jewelry was used in Afghan society long ago. Take a look at the variety of jewelry in this exhibition and become inspired to create your own heirlooms!

What you need:

Gold foil, stylus (or pencil), wire, string, beads, scissor, hole puncher



How to:

1. Look at the shapes and motifs in the jewelry of the exhibition



2. Cut foil into your desired shape using a pair of scissors



3. Use a stylus (or a pen or pencil) to engrave your design into the metal foil



4. Use a piece of wire to connect beads to your gold foil piece



5. Tie string to the finished jewelry to make a necklace
