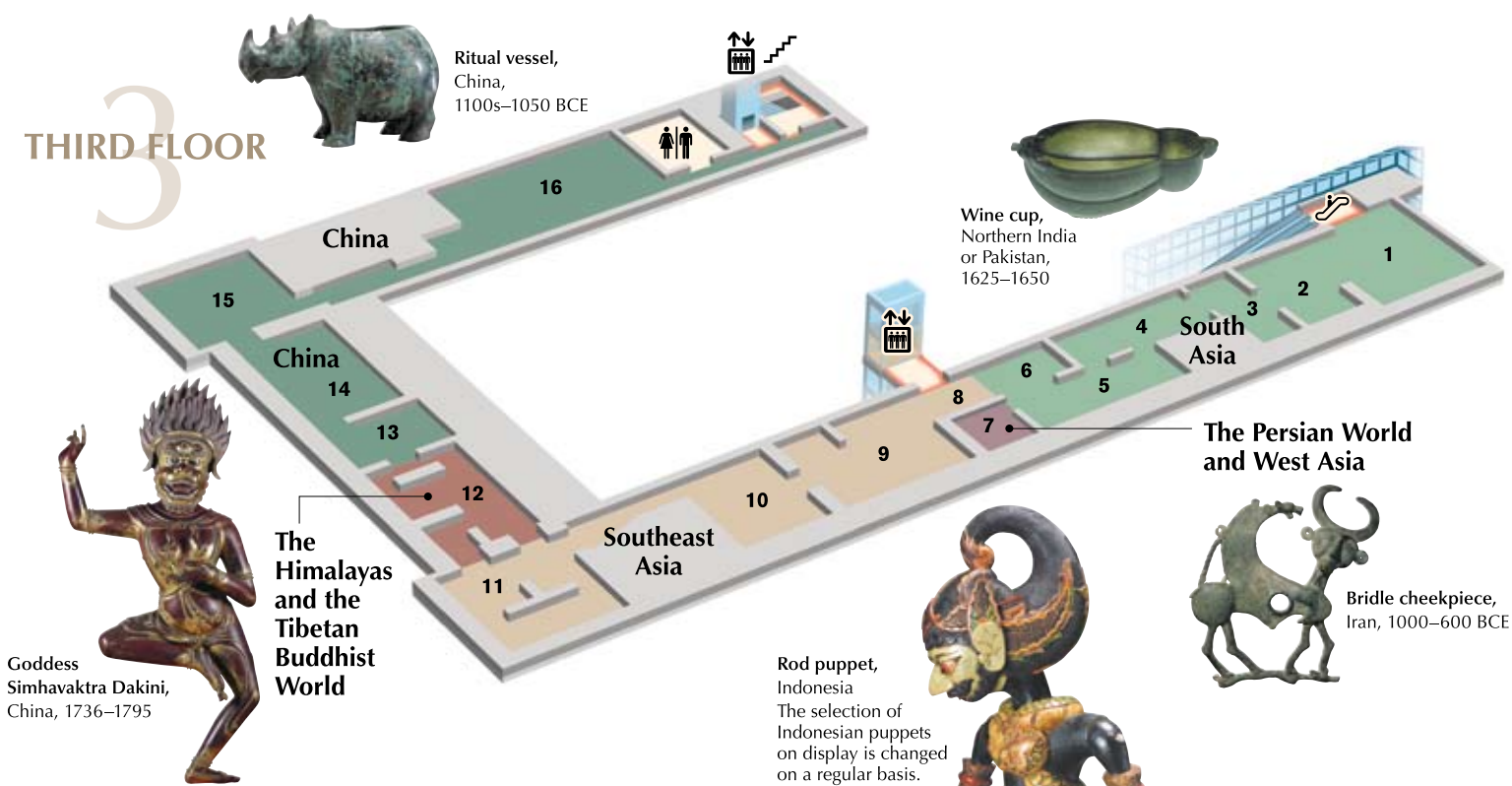


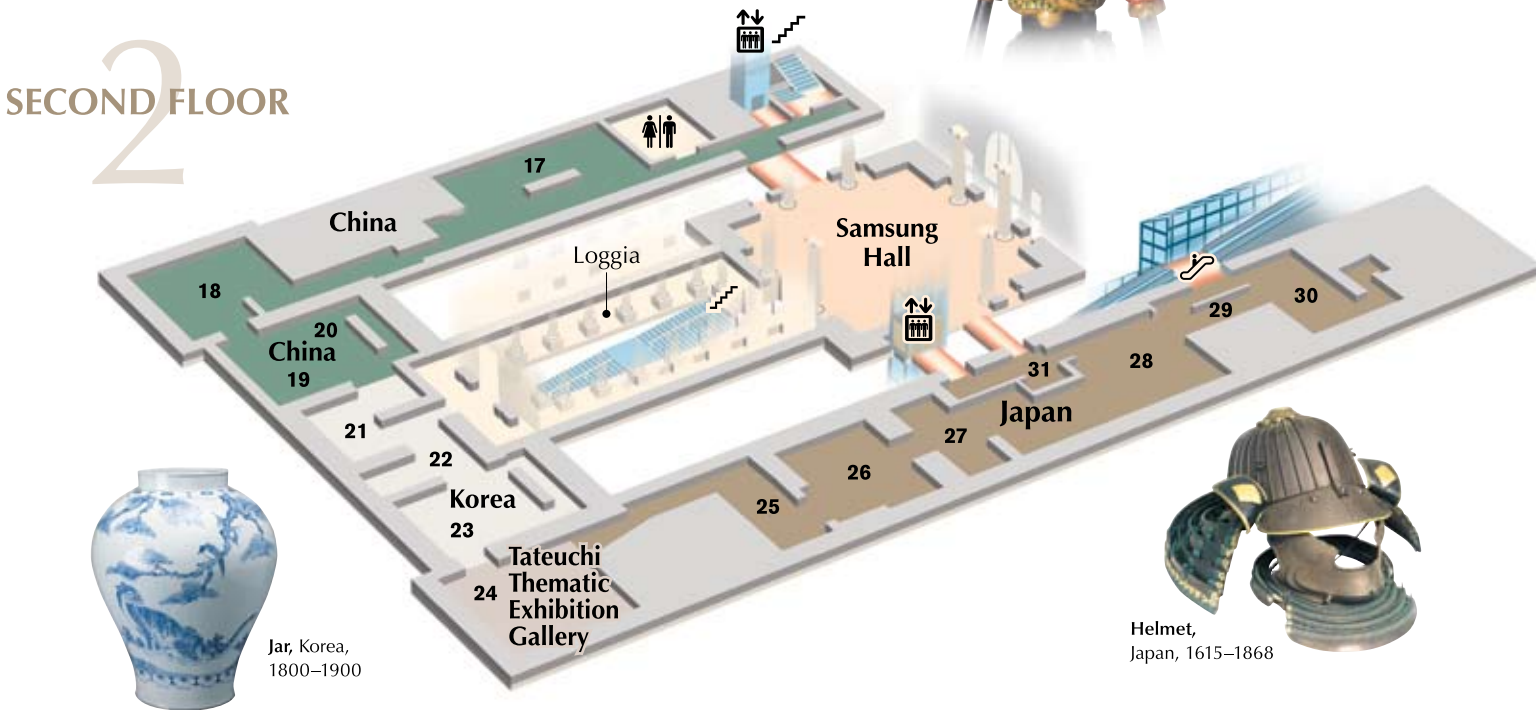

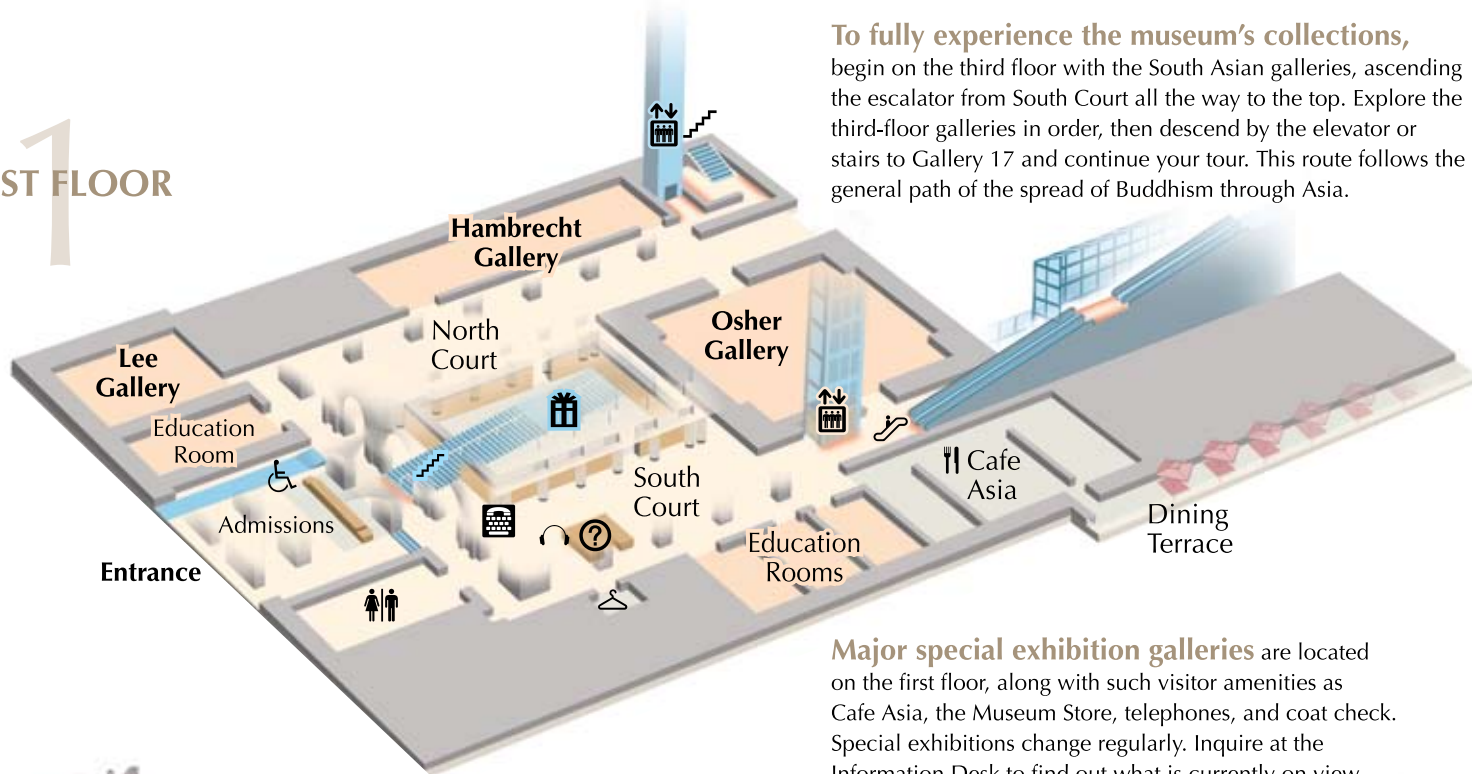

FIRST FLOOR

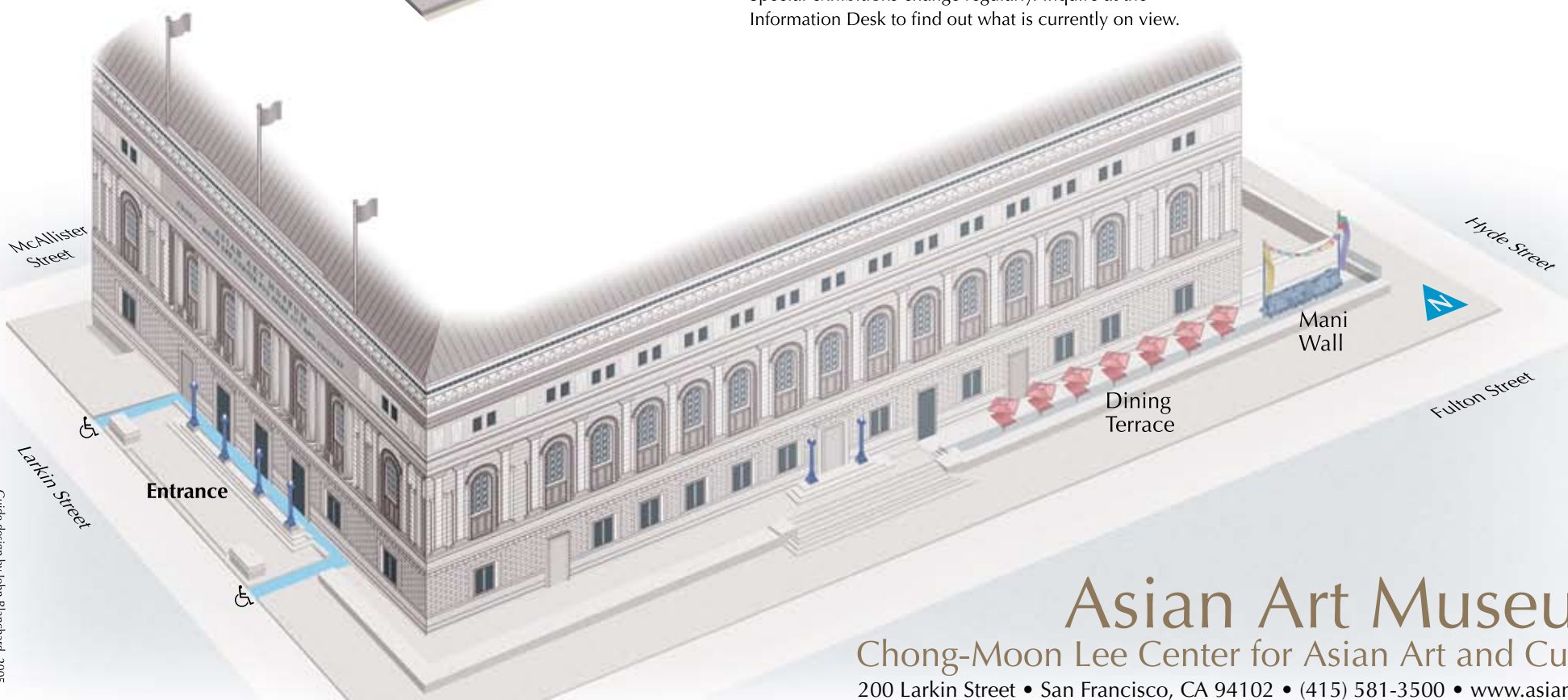


To fully experience the museum's collections, begin on the third floor with the South Asian galleries, ascending the escalator from South Court all the way to the top. Explore the third-floor galleries in order, then descend by the elevator or stairs to Gallery 17 and continue your tour. This route follows the general path of the spread of Buddhism through Asia.

Major special exhibition galleries are located on the first floor, along with such visitor amenities as Cafe Asia, the Museum Store, telephones, and coat check. Special exhibitions change regularly. Inquire at the Information Desk to find out what is currently on view.
